In this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the Vacation/Termination Notices dated 29.11.2017 (Annexure P-2), 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) and 15.01.2018 (Annexure P-8) and the proceedings subsequent thereto. Further, a direction has been sought to the respondents not to invite the tender for the Chemist Shop No.4 NSC for sale of medicine, drugs and surgical items.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has no instructions to pursue the case.

3. In view of the above, the writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
