Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of military service rendered by them during the Second National Emergency towards pension AND FURTHER to give all the consequential benefits arising therefrom such as arrears of pension etc.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though a representation was made to the respondent No.2 on 07.12.2017 (P-7) but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents particularly respondent No.3 to decide the aforesaid representation (P-7) in a time bound manner.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly respondent No.3 – The Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the representation dated 07.12.2017 (P-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in the light of the judgment passed in Civil Writ Petition No.17661 of 2013 & some other connected petitions captioned as ***Rajinder Singh vs. State of Punjab & ors.*** decided on 13.11.2014 (P-6), as per the version of the learned counsel for the petitioners, which has attained finality and has already been implemented, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
