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RAJESH BINDAL, J:

Order dated 13.08.2015, passed by the learned Single Judge has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

While allowing the writ petition, the learned Single Judge has placed reliance upon an earlier Division Bench judgment of this Court dated 28.09.2010 in LPA No. 713 of 2010 titled as “The Punjab State Electricity Board and another vs. Thana Singh and others”.

At the time of hearing, it was pointed out that SLP (C) Nos. 35109-12 of 2012 against the aforesaid judgment are pending before Hon'ble the Supreme Court.

Learned counsel for the parties agreed that the present appeal may be disposed of as the parties to the dispute shall abide by the final order to be passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the aforesaid SLPs (C) where the same issue is under consideration in challenge to the order passed by this Court in LPA No. 713 of 2010.

In view of the aforesaid fair stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of the present appeal by directing that the parties

shall abide by the final order to be passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in the aforesaid SLPs (C) pending before it.

This order has been passed to avoid further litigation as otherwise this Court has already opined in favour of the respondents.
