The present letter patent appeal is directed against the judgment and order dated 29.07.2013 passed by learned Single Judge in CWP No.357 of 2011.

Learned Single Judge allowed the civil writ petition filed by Nagender Singh-respondent herein.

The present appeal was admitted for hearing by this Court on 13.05.2015 and on the application made by the respondent-Nagender Singh, as aforesaid, the appeal is taken up for hearing.

The original petitioner, respondent herein-Nagender Singh has filed affidavit in the Court today, which is taken on record and marked as Mark 'X' for identification. The same shall form part and parcel of the record. Respondent-Nagender Singh has specifically stated in the affidavit that he is ready and willing to get seniority from the Rohtak Range.

In that view of the matter, accepting the statement made by respondent-Nagender Singh in the affidavit, we make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) LPA No.32 of 2014 is allowed.
- (ii) Impugned judgment and order dated 29.07.2013 passed by learned Single Judge, is set aside.
- (iii) The respondent would be entitled to seniority as per the Rohtak Range, which shall be implemented within a period of eight weeks from today.
