SURYA KANT J. (Oral)

(1) This order shall disposed of LPA Nos.194, 293, 301, 306, 307, 311, 407, 408, 896 of 2015; 855 & 1320 of 2016 as the point in issue is common and all these appeals assail the order dated 23.12.2014 passed by learned Single Judge.

(2) During the course of hearing, it is informed that no challan has been presented so far against the appellants, in the registered cases though investigation is statedly going on.

(3) In this view of the matter, these appeals are disposed of with a clarificatory direction that in case CBI submits any supplementary challan against any of the appellant(s), in that event, the observations, if any, made by learned Single Judge shall have no bearing on the merits of the trial and no prejudice shall be caused to him/them by such observations. Such appellant(s) shall be at liberty to raise all the pleas before the learned trial court at an appropriate stage and the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

(4) With these observations/clarification/directions, the appeals stand disposed of.
