Counsel for the respondent informs that the respondent could not appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre as she has not been granted any alimony.

Case called twice. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant.

Perusal of the judgment of the lower Court indicates that the respondent-wife has been granted decree of divorce on the basis of evidence produced by her whereas the appellant-husband had failed to pay any maintenance as per order passed in application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act.

It appears that the appellant-husband is not interested in seriously contesting claim of the respondent-wife for divorce for which reason he has been adopting casual approach before the lower Court as well as before this Court.

The appeal is dismissed in default.
