Instant application has been filed under Section 5 of Limitation Act seeking condonation of delay of 346 days that has occurred in filing the accompanying appeal.

In view of the averments made in the application and coupled with the fact that it is a claimants' appeal seeking enhancement of compensation, prayer is allowed.

Application is allowed.

Delay is condoned.

Main Appeal

This is claimants' appeal seeking enhancement of compensation.

Briefly, it may be noticed that vide award dated 30.11.2015 passed by the M.A.C.T, Sonapat, a total compensation amount of Rs.18,93,160/- along with interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till actual realization has been awarded in favour of the claimants on account of death of Ram Narain in a motor vehicle accident that took place on 15.1.2015.

During the course of arguments counsel has not been able to dispute that the compensation amount computed by the Tribunal is as per guidelines/parameters issued by the Apex Court in ***Smt. Sarla Verma and others Vs. Delhi Transport Corporation & another, 2009 (3) R.C.R (Civil), 77*** and ***National Insurance Company Limited Vs. Pranay Sethi and others, 2017(4) R.C.R. (Civil), 1009.***

No scope for enhancement is made out.

Appeal is dismissed.
