Challenge in this letters patent appeal is the order dated
16.08.2016 passed by learned Single Judge of this Court in CWP No.20664
of 2014.

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that in the
application i.e. CM No.4443-LPA-2018, the following stand has been taken

by the respondent :-

“That after the last date of hearing dated 12/9/2018, the DHBVN has issued Sale Circular No.D-24/2018 dated 22/09/2018 for out of Court settlement of pending Electricity Bill of defaulting consumers. In pursuance of said scheme, the appellant was also offered to settle the disputed bill under the said Settlement Scheme vide Memo No.1332 dated 16.10.2008 offering to pay total amount of Rs.2,65,010/-. The appellant settled the dispute with the respondent Corporation by adjusting the said amount and has given affidavit that he has been left with no further grievance against the respondent Nigam and also received cost of Rs.20,000/- as imposed by this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 12/9/2018 and further undertaking that he will withdraw the LPA No.1717 of 2016. The affidavit of the appellant is enclosed herewith as Annexure R/1.”

In view of the above, learned counsel for the parties submitted that the appeal has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
