Prayer in this application is for condoning delay of 46 days in filing the appeal.

In view of averments made in the application and arguments advanced, application is allowed and delay of 46 days in filing the appeal stands condoned.

Disposed of accordingly.

FAO No. 4324 of 2017

The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of

compensation in regard to injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 12.4.2015.

The Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Sangrur (in short “the Tribunal”) has awarded compensation to the tune of Rs. 1,25,980/-, detailed hereunder:-

Medical Expenditure	Rs. 35,980/-
Pain and suffering	Rs. 30,000/-
Adverse affect on future prospects	Rs. 25,000/-
Transportation	Rs. 10,000/-
Special diet	Rs. 10,000/-
Loss of income	Rs. 15,000/-

Counsel for the appellant has failed to advance any meaningful arguments to substantiate plea of the claimant for grant of compensation over and above what has been allowed by the Tribunal. Rather it appears that the Tribunal has shown magnanimity in allowing compensation particularly towards pain and suffering and adverse affect on future prospects. That being so, appeal sans merit and liable to be dismissed.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed. No order as to costs.
