The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation. The Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs.19,61,000/- represented in a tabulated form in para 27 of the award. The Tribunal has assessed income of the deceased at Rs.9000/- per month as per claim made by the applicants and allowed addition in income for future prospects to the extent of 50%. When the case is examined in the light of latest judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court **National Insurance Company Ltd. Vs. Pranay Sethi and others, 2017 SCC 1270**, there is no scope for enhancement of compensation. That being so, the appeal sans merit and liable to be dismissed.

Ordered accordingly.
