Aggrieved by the dismissal of his petition for divorce,
the husband has preferred this appeal.

During pendency of the appeal, the parties arrived at a
settlement before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to the
effect that they would get the marriage dissolved by filing a petition under
Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, within 20 days after the
settlement. The original settlement/compromise dated 16.2.2018, is taken on
record as EX.CX which shall form part of the record.

Counsel for the respondent informs that a petition under
Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, has already been filed which is
fixed for second motion on 11.9.2018.

In view of said circumstances, this appeal is dismissed as
having rendered infructuous without prejudice to the rights of the parties to
approach this Court for revival in case there is breach of any obligation
arising out of settlement EX.CX.
