On 03.04.2018, this Court had passed the following order: -

“Separate power of attorneys filed on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5 are taken on record. Office to tag the same at the appropriate place.

As per office report, notices issued to respondents No. 1 to 3 have been received back unserved for want of addresses.

Let fresh notices be issued to respondents No. 1 to 3 for 31.08.2018, through ordinary process, registered post and *dasti* as well, on filing of their correct addresses along with registered covers, process-fee, requisite copies and incidental expenses within a period of 15 days from today.

It is clarified that failure to comply with this order would entail dismissal of instant petition.”

As per the afore quoted order, fresh notices were to be issued to respondents No. 1 to 3 for today on filing of their correct addresses alongwith registered covers, profess fee, requisite copies and incidental expenses within fifteen days from the date of the order. It was further clarified that failure to comply with the afore quoted order would entail dismissal of the petition.

As per the office report, notices to respondents No. 1 to 3 could not be issued as learned counsel for the appellant did not file the correct addresses and process fee.

That being so, in terms of the afore quoted order of this Court dated 03.04.2018, the present appeal is dismissed.
