

LAJJO DEVI & ANR. VS STATE OF HARYANA

As per the communication dated 23.01.2018, received from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, a clarification is sought regarding FIR No. 27 dated 24.07.2009 in which order has been passed in Criminal Revision No. 196 of 2011 titled as 'Lajjo Devi & Anr. vs. State of Haryana'. Lajjo Devi preferred Criminal Revision No. 196 of 2011 arising out of the judgment dated 7.11.2009 and order of sentence dated 09.11.2009 passed by the learned trial Court in FIR No. 27 dated 24.07.1999 under Sections 498-A/ 406/ 506/ 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jathlana. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri while deciding the said matter noted down FIR No. 27 dated 24.07.2009 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 IPC, Police Station Jathlana in his judgment dated 07.11.2009 and inadvertantly a mistake crept in at that juncture. It should have been a judgment rendered in FIR No. 27 dated **24.07.1999** under Sections 498-A/ 406/ 506/ 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jathlana. Consequently, the orders passed in Criminal Revision No. 196 of 2011 titled as 'Lajjo Devi & Anr. vs. State of Haryana' are to be read in FIR No. 27 dated 24.07.1999 under Sections 498-A/ 406/ 506/ 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jathlana.

The office is also directed to carry out the necessary correction in the petition as well as the judgment dated 06.12.2017 passed by this Court.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners herein seeks extension in time for payment of enhanced fine.

Time to deposit the fine is extended for the period of another two weeks from today.

With the abovesaid clarification, the office note is dealt with.
