Aggrieved by dismissal of his divorce petition, the husband has preferred this appeal. Notice was issued to the respondent but despite service, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent today.

Counsel for the appellant submits that the parties have mutually agreed to get divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act and seeks withdrawal of the appeal.

The appeal is dismissed as withdrawn without prejudice to the rights of the parties to seek decree of divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. A sum of Rs.25,000/- towards interim litigation expenses may be recovered by the respondent-wife in accordance with law.
