This appeal has arisen from the judgement and decree dated 02.08.2017 passed by the Family Court, S.B.S. Nagar by which the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') by the appellant-wife was allowed.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent that during the pendency of this appeal, the parties to the *lis* have filed the petition under Section 13-B of the Act, dissolving their marriage by way of a decree of divorce by mutual consent. The said petition has been decided by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Phillaur vide judgment and decree dated 03.11.2018 and marriage between the parties has been dissolved. It is further submitted that since, the marriage has already been dissolved therefore, the present appeal filed against the judgement and decree passed under Section 9 of the Act has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
