This appeal has arisen from an order dated 18.01.2018, passed by the trial Court by which an application filed under Section 19 of the Hindu Adoptions and Maintenance Act, 1956 against her father-in-law for the payment of maintenance has been allowed.

Both the parties have entered into an oral compromise before us. As per the compromise, appellant/father-in-law has decided to transfer 5 Kanals of land in favour of his grandson namely; Jashanpreet Singh, born on 28.05.2005.

In view thereof, the present appeal has become infructuous and dismissed as such.

It is needless to mention that the transfer of land would be effected by executing a registered transfer deed by the appellant in favour of his grandson Jashanpreet Singh. This transfer of land shall settle all claims of the respondent/daughter-in-law against the appellant/father-in-law. In case,

the transfer is not done within a period of two months, the appellant may file an appropriate application for revival of the present appeal.

It is further ordered that any suit filed by the respondent to create a charge over the property in question shall also be withdrawn.
