This appeal has been filed against the award dated 19.05.2018 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridabad granting compensation of Rs.2,65,300/- to respondent No.1 for injury which he sustained in an accident.

The sole contention of the learned counsel for the appellant is that the appellant had sold the vehicle in the year 2010 to respondent No.3 and the accident had taken place in the year 2013. He has however accepted that the vehicle was not transferred in the name of respondent No.3 and the registration continued to be in the name of the appellant. The Supreme Court in *Naveen Kumar Vs. Vijay Kumar and others, 2018 (2) RCR (Civil) 74* held that where registered owner transfers vehicle but continues to be reflected in records of Registering Authority as owner, he would not be absolved of liability.

In the circumstances, no fault can be found with the order of the tribunal foisting the liability on the appellant.

Appeal stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
