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**REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)**

The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of death of Sandeep Kumar in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 07.09.2015.

The Tribunal in paras 20 to 22 has dealt with computation of loss of dependency as well as compensation under conventional heads and eventually awarded compensation to the tune of Rs.22,89,960/- (rounded of to Rs.22,90,000/-).

I have gone through the assessment made by the Tribunal but find that the Tribunal has awarded compensation more than what can be allowed to the claimants when the case is examined in the light of latest judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court **National Insurance Company Limited Vs. Pranay Sethi and Ors., 2017 SCC 1270**. That being so, there is no justification for enhancement of compensation.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine.
