Counsel for the appellant would inform that the suit was filed by Rattan Lal – respondent No.1 for possession by way of partition of house in which Nirmala Devi – appellant was impleaded as defendant No.2. The parties to the litigation are the children of Hardwari Lal son of Sant Ram resident of District Mansa. The suit was dismissed by the trial Court vide judgment and decree dated 29.03.2012. The appeal preferred by unsuccessful plaintiff was partly allowed and Sh. Rattan Lal was held to be co-owner in the suit property to the extent of 1/5th share.

Counsel for the appellant would inform that Smt. Nirmala Devi has since passed away and she was married and issueless and as such the appeal preferred by Nirmala Devi is not pressed on merits and may be disposed of.
