Vide impugned order dated 08.09.2017, the Guardian Judge, Chandigarh had allowed petition under Section 9 of the Guardians and Wards Act filed by the respondents allowing them to meet the minor grandson once in a month on 15th of every month at Mediation Centre, Sector 43, Chandigarh.

During pendency of the appeal, the parties have entered into a compromise, copy of which is placed on record as Ex.CX which is made part of the record.

The appeal is disposed of as the dispute having been compromised vide settlement agreement Ex.CX. The parties will remain bound by the terms of the settlement Ex.CX.

In case of any violation of any of the settlement conditions, it will be open to any of the parties to file application under Section 43 of the Guardians and Wards Act for regulating the conduct and enforcement of this order based upon the terms of the settlement Ex.CX.

Miscellaneous application i.e. CM-27643-CII-2017 is also disposed of.
