Appellant-wife Jashandeep Kaur, present in the Court, has stated that pursuant to the terms of settlement Ex. CX, she has received a sum of Rs.7,50,000/- for her son and towards alimony. She would withdraw the cases mentioned in para 7 of the settlement. She has submitted that she has got no objection in case the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of said circumstances, Ex. CX is made part of the record. Parties will remain bound by the terms of Ex. CX.

In case of violation of any of the terms, it will be open to any of the parties to approach this Court for revival of the appeal.

The appeal is dismissed as withdrawn on the basis of settlement Ex. CX.

The application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act along with other miscellaneous applications are also disposed of as withdrawn.
