This appeal (FAO-M-310-2017) has arisen from the judgment and decree dated 03.03.2015 passed by the Additional District Judge, Sangrur by which petition filed by the appellant-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') for dissolution of his marriage by way of a decree of divorce was dismissed.

The parties had appeared in the Court on 16.05.2018 and recorded their statements at the first motion stage. Hearing of the case was deferred to 21.11.2018 for recording their statements at the second motion stage.

Both the parties are present in Court today and their statements have been recorded separately at second motion stage. We have asked both of them separately as to whether they are still ready and willing to part ways by way of a decree of divorce in terms of the settlement. Both the parties

namely Baghel Singh (husband) and Bhupinder Kaur (wife), have stated

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that they do not want to live together and are sticking to their statements made at the first motion stage.

Thus, in view thereof, the present petition filed under Section 13-B of the Act is hereby allowed and the marriage of the parties, which was performed on 27.06.2012, is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent.
