This appeal is preferred by the appellant-wife in whose favour an ex-parte judgment and decree dated 14.10.2016 has been passed by the trial Court. Not only that the appeal is not maintainable because the appellant is not an aggrieved party but also there is a delay of 717 days in filing the appeal which is sought to be condoned by way of the accompanying application bearing No. CM-25134-CII-2018.

We have heard learned counsel for the applicant-appellant both on the appeal as well as application filed for condonation of delay and are of the considered opinion that neither there is sufficient ground to condone the delay nor the appeal itself is maintainable.

In view of the above, the appeal same is hereby dismissed.
