Aggrieved against the order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition, present intra-court appeal has been filed by the petitioner who appeared in the UGC-NET December 2015 Test. He deposited the prescribed fee and raised issue regarding correctness of answer keys of 11 questions in three papers. The matter was put to the Expert Committee by the Central Board of Secondary Education. The said Committee found that there was error in answer key of question No.30 only which was revised but still finding that the petitioner had not answered the same correctly, therefore, no marks were awarded to him.

Learned counsel for the appellant sought to argue that there were errors in other questions as well. However, we find that the matter having been examined by the Expert Committee, this Court cannot sit in judgment over their view who are the experts on the subject.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The present appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of 91 days' delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
