The writ petition filed by the appellant for ante-dating his promotion w.e.f. 21.9.2007 from the post of JBT Teacher to Sanskrit Teacher, was dismissed.

The learned Single Judge has recorded that promotions could not take place as some of the employees had filed civil suit. Immediately after the civil suit was decided on 7.2.2008, the matter was taken up and promotions were made. The appellant claimed that he should be deemed to have been promoted from the date proposal was sent to the competent authority. It cannot be a matter of right to claim promotion from that date, once it could not be established that any person junior to the appellant had

been promoted. There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
