Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 25.04.2013 dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, an application seeking condonation of 1334 days' delay in filing thereof, has also been filed.

The only ground raised in the application is that the applicant/appellant did not come to know about the order passed. The same can hardly be an explanation once the applicant/appellant was represented by counsel and the applicant/appellant was pursuing his remedy with reference to grant of stage carriage permit.

There being no reasonable ground made out for condonation of huge delay of 1334 days in filing the appeal, the application seeking

condonation of delay is dismissed. Consequently, the appeal is also dismissed.
