By filing the present intra-court appeal, judgment dated 30.05.2016 passed by the learned Single Judge in a bunch matter has been impugned. Along with the present appeal, an application seeking condonation of delay of 336 days in filing thereof has been filed.

The only ground mentioned in the application is that the applicant/appellant had been discussing the case with the counsel and making necessary documents available to the counsel for preparation of the appeal. The said ground can hardly be said to be a reasonable to condone huge delay of 336 days in the filing the appeal as the documents are required to be available with the litigant when the writ petition was filed. The challenge in the present intra-court appeal is to the judgment of the learned Single Judge. We do not find that any ground is made out to condone huge delay of 336 days in filing the appeal.

Accordingly, the application seeking condonation of 336 days’ delay in filing the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the appeal is also dismissed.
