RAJESH BINDAL, J:

It is a strange case in which the gram panchayat as a litigant is trying to raise dispute on khasra No. 60 which is recorded in the revenue record as cremation ground, by contending that it should be treated as *shamlat deh*.

The learned Single Judge while considering the entire material on record had opined that the same is recorded as cremation ground. Even if the contention raised by learned counsel for the appellant is accepted that there is another cremation ground in the village, we could not find out what interest the gram panchayat has in converting this khasra as the *shamlat deh*.

The appeal is totally frivolous and apparently has been filed for oblique motive.

The same is dismissed with costs of ₹25,000/- to be deposited with the Registry of this Court within one month. Application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
