MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral) :

 This appeal is directed against the judgment of learned Single Judge dated 11.7.2017.

 The appellant participated in the selection process of Constables and cleared all the procedures but was unable to appear for the interview. The reason given is that there were riots in the area where he was staying on 23.5.2017 and Internet facility was not available from 24.5.2017 to 3.6.2017 and 8.6.2017 to 12.6.2017, which hampered the communications, depriving him of the information of dates of interview.

 The stand is, however, falsified by the disclosure made by the State that interviews were open from 6.6.2017 to 8.6.2017 and from 12.6.2017 to 20.6.2017, which has given sufficient room to the appellant to appear in the interview. There is nothing on record to suggest that any representation has been made to the respondents during this process.

We, thus, do not find any ground to interfere in the order impugned.
