This appeal is against the judgment of the learned Single Judge dated 03.07.2017 upholding the order of the Financial Commissioner in selecting respondent No.4 as Lambardar.

The material that weighed with the authorities to discard the appellant's claim for Lambardar is of his indulging in theft of canal water and electricity. The impropriety of the conduct itself is sufficient to discard the claim of the appellant to the post of Lambardar. We, therefore, cannot find fault with the findings of the learned Single Judge in upholding the orders of the Financial Commissioner and other revenue authorities, who have held likewise.

Appeal dismissed.
