The matter was passed over in the initial call since learned counsel appearing for the appellant was not present. In the revised call also there is no representation on behalf of the appellant. The appeal has been filed along with an application for staying the proceedings before the Permanent Lok Adalat & Public Utility Services Court, Fatehabad. Writ petition filed by the appellant, challenging the order dated 10.07.2015, was dismissed mainly on the ground that pleas being raised before the Court were purely factual in nature, which cannot be gone into and decided in writ jurisdiction.

Having gone through the record, we see no reason to differ from the view taken by learned Single Judge. The appeal is devoid of merits and accordingly stands dismissed.
