Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 27.09.2016 dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. The appeal is accompanied by an application seeking condonation of 215 days' delay in filing thereof.

The only ground raised in the application is that the applicant/appellant was pursuing his representation before the Chief Secretary. In fact after the decision of CWP No.4306 of 2001 filed earlier by the applicant/appellant on 08.07.2015, he sought certain modifications. Order was passed on 03.02.2016 directing the Chief Secretary to take a decision. The Chief Secretary decided the issue on 19.03.2016. It was thereafter that the writ petition was decided by this Court on 27.09.2016. Despite this fact, the applicant/appellant found it appropriate to pursue his representations before

the Chief Secretary. That can hardly be considered a reasonable ground to condone huge delay of 215 days in filing the appeal.

Accordingly, the application seeking condonation of 215 days' delay in filing the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the appeal is also dismissed.
