The order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 9.2.2015 directing registration of a document has been impugned in the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, application seeking condonation of delay of 871 days in filing the appeal has been filed.

The affidavits, originally filed and even subsequently filed to explain the delay do not make out a case for condoning huge delay of 871 days in filing thereof. All what has been mentioned is that the officers/staff are over-burdened and they remained busy in other works, as if the court cases are not to be taken seriously and appeals are to be filed at ease of the officers concerned, which cannot be expected. None has been held responsible for causing delay in filing appeal.

We do not find that any ground is made out for condoning the delay of 871 days in filing the appeal.

Accordingly, the application is dismissed. Consequently, the appeal is also dismissed.
