This order will dispose of a bunch of five appeals bearing LPA Nos.1583 to 1586 and 1590 of 2017 as common questions of law and facts are involved. However, the facts have been extracted from LPA No.1583 of 2017.

Common order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing bunch of petitions where challenge was to the order passed by the authorities regarding partition of the land, has been challenged in the present intra-court appeal.

The contention raised is that there was family partition thirty years ago in terms of which the appellant was given inferior quality of land which was improved by spending huge amount and further the quality of land has not been taken care of while applying the mode of partition.

After hearing learned counsel for the appellant, we do not find any merit in the present appeal.

Document (Annexure P-9) alleged agreement of exchange of land which is claimed to have been executed on 16.10.1986 was not produced before any of the authorities below. Though the claim was made that there was a family partition which was placed on record for the first time along with the writ petition, hence was rightly not considered to be relevant. In the order passed by the Assistant Collector dated 12.09.2014 (Annexure P-3) it has specifically been mentioned that if any number falls adjoining to the road then the same will be given as per share. Hence, we do not find that there is any grievance to this extent.

There is no merit in the present set of appeals. Accordingly, the same are dismissed.
