This appeal has arisen from an order passed by the Family Court dated 04.09.2017 by which a petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 [for short 'the Act'] by the appellant for dissolution of marriage by way of a decree of divorce was dismissed. It is submitted that the parties have entered into a settlement on 29.8.2018. A copy of the settlement is also placed on record.
