KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Vide order dated 09.08.2018, a Coordinate Division Bench required the appellant to deposit the amount as per award along with interest by way of FDR with the Registrar Judicial of this Court before the next date of hearing which deposit was subject to the final outcome of this appeal.

Today, when the matter is called out, learned counsel for the appellant states that since the appellant is in jail having been arrested about a month back is not in a position to comply with the aforesaid order and necessary instructions have also not been issued. The order is dated 09.08.2018 and as stated by learned counsel for the appellants the arrest was affected a month back sometimes in the beginning of the October, thus, the appellant had full two months to comply with the order dated 09.08.2018, however, he failed to do so. It appears that he is not interested to prosecute this appeal. The appeal is not liable to proceed any further unless the order dated 9.8.2018 is complied. Accordingly, the appeal stands dismissed for non-compliance of the order dated 9.8.2018.
