This appeal has arisen from the judgement and decree dated 09.01.2018 by which the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent-wife was allowed and the marriage solemnized with the appellant-husband as per sikh rites and ceremonies was dissolved by a decree of divorce.

The appellant-husband was directed by this Court to pay a sum of ₹25,000/- to the respondent wife towards interim litigation expenses but since it was not paid, therefore, he was asked to pay another ₹5000/- to the respondent-wife towards travelling expenses.

Today, learned counsel for the appellant has prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw this appeal as the appellant is unable to pay the amount towards interim litigation and travelling expenses as ordered by this Court.

Since, this appeal is filed at the instance of the appellant-husband and he does not want to pursue, therefore, the same is hereby

dismissed as withdrawn with a rider that the respondent-wife may recover the amount awarded by this Court in accordance with law.
