This appeal is filed by the husband who has been unsuccessful in his petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') before the learned trial Court.

At the time of issuing notice of motion, the appellant was directed to bring a draft of ₹25,000/- in the name of the respondent on the next date of hearing towards the interim litigation expenses

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted he is not in contact with the appellant and thus, he has prayed that this appeal may be dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to file an appropriate application for its revival in case the appellant is willing to pay ₹ 25,000/- as an interim litigation expenses to the respondent-wife.
