Interim order dated 25.7.2017 passed in a bunch of petitions,
where selection and appointment of Primary Teachers is in dispute, has
been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

As there were allegations with regard to impersonation in
different tests conducted for selection to the aforesaid posts, the learned
Single Judge had passed various interim orders, even after the impugned
order was passed, to ensure that the candidates who were selected had not

indulged in any kind of manipulation or impersonation in the process of selection.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, we do not find it appropriate to interfere with the interim order passed, where certain observations had been made during the course of hearing of the petitions, which are listed on 27.4.2018.

The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, all the accompanying applications are also dismissed.
