Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 03.07.2017 dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The issue pertains to the appointment of Lambardar for village Mughal Chak, Sub Tehsil Dhilwan, Tehsil and District Kapurthala. From the stage of Collector till decision by the learned Single Judge, appointment of respondent No.4 as Lambardar has been upheld. All the authorities have examined the comparative merit and the issues raised. The litigation is continuing for the last more than eight years.

In view of the aforesaid facts, we do not find any reason to re-appreciate the entire material, once the matter has already been considered and examined by four authorities.

Accordingly, the appeal has no merit and the same is dismissed. Consequently, the accompanying application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
