The order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 14.2.2013 has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, an application seeking condonation of delay of 1,634 days in filing thereof has also been filed.

The prayer made in the petition filed in the year 2013 was for issuance of direction to the respondents therein to allow the appellant to join as Computer Teacher in pursuance to the appointment letter issued in the year 2008. The writ petition having been filed more than 4 years from the date cause of action arose to the appellant, was dismissed. It has further been noticed by the learned Single Judge that the appellant had obtained the qualification required for the post after the cut-off date, hence, was not eligible.

The only ground raised in the application for condonation of delay of 1,634 days in filing the appeal is that the applicant-appellant was not aware of the law of limitation. That can hardly be accepted as a ground to condone huge delay of 1,634 days in filing the appeal.

We do not find any merit either in the application for condonation of delay or in the appeal. Accordingly, the same are dismissed.
