Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 15.05.2017, dismissing the writ petition, has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The appellant retired from service on 31.07.2002. He filed CWP No.18549 of 2013, claiming that service rendered from 01.12.1969 to 24.01.1974 with Beas Satluj Link Project be treated as qualifying service for grant of pensionary benefits. The aforesaid writ petition was allowed on 05.01.2016 and the appellant was granted the said benefit. Thereafter, the present writ petition was filed claiming that the aforesaid period be counted towards grant of notional promotion as well. The same has been dismissed by the learned Single Judge being highly belated having been filed more than 15 years after his retirement. Even otherwise, once the appellant had earlier filed a writ petition claiming benefit of his service rendered with Beas Satluj Link

Project, all reliefs pertaining to that period should have been claimed in that petition only and not by filing separate petitions.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
