The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition pertaining to a dispute regarding partition of land has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

It has been recorded by the learned Single Judge that no grievance was raised by the appellant at the relevant time and at the stage when *naksha bey* was prepared. It has further been noticed that mode of partition was sanctioned without any objection.

With the aforesaid facts on record, we do not find that any case is made out for interference in the present appeal. Accordingly, the same is

dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in re-filing the appeal is also dismissed.
