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RAJESH BINDAL, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge allowing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Alongwith the appeal, application seeking condonation of delay of 245 days in filing the appeal has also been filed.

In the case in hand, learned Single Judge directed the grant of ex-gratia payment to the son of the deceased employee, who had died in harness on 10.11.1993 in terms of Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 (for short – '2006 Rules'). It is not disputed that the case of the respondent was pending when the 2006 Rules came into force and in term clause 6 of the 2006 Rules, all pending compassionate cases are to be dealt with under the 2006 Rules.

Considering the aforesaid facts, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed and consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing of the appeal is also dismissed.
