Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 17.05.2017 dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

Challenge in the writ petition filed in the year 2006 is to the allotment letter dated 16.11.1988 issued by the Punjab Wakf Board in favour of Rajinder Kumar Sharma (respondent No.3). Writ petition was dismissed as the period of lease was only for 11 months commencing from May 1988 as the appellant could not establish his locus to challenge the lease. Even civil litigation initiated by the appellant was disposed of by the learned Wakf Tribunal on 21.10.2005 on a stand taken by the appellant therein that writ petition regarding the suit property is pending in this Court which in fact was incorrect as on that day there was no writ petition pending in this Court

pertaining to the property in question. It was only after the disposal of the petition filed by the appellant before the Wakf Tribunal that the present writ petition was filed.

For the reasons mentioned above, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Hence, the present appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
