The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The dispute pertains to the appointment of Lambardar. The contest was between the appellant and respondent No. 4. The Collector appointed respondent No. 4 as Lambardar, however, the Divisional Commissioner, in appeal filed by the present appellant, set aside his appointment holding the appellant as well as respondent No. 4 ineligible for the post of Lambardar and directed the Collector to start the process afresh. The order was upheld by the Financial Commissioner as well as the learned Single Judge of this Court.

The undisputed fact on record is that father of the appellant is in unauthorised possession of the panchayat land. The only plea sought to be raised to explain the same is that the appellant is living separate from his

father. In support, a ration card was produced, which was got prepared

during the pendency of the proceedings, hence, has rightly been discarded by the authorities. All the issues have been considered threadbare by the learned Single Judge.

There is no merit in the present appeal. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
