The order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 12.07.2017 has been challenged by filing the present intra-court appeal.

Challenge made in the writ petition was to the order dated 11.05.2010 passed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab and order dated 22.09.2016 passed by the State Transport Appellate Tribunal, Punjab (for short “the Tribunal”).

The grievance of the appellant was that his application for grant of Regular Stage Carriage Permit was rejected on illegal grounds.

It is not in dispute that against the order dated 11.05.2010 passed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, appeal was maintainable to the Tribunal, for which limitation is 60 days. The appellant did not prefer any appeal. He filed CWP No.12332 of 2012 in this Court

which was withdrawn on 04.07.2012 to enable him to avail the remedy of appeal. Even thereafter appeal was filed more than one year later on 02.08.2013 which was dismissed by the Tribunal vide order dated 22.09.2016 as time barred.

As the appeal filed by the appellant before the Tribunal was highly belated having been filed three years after the passing of the order impugned before the Tribunal, the same was rightly dismissed.

We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

For the reasons stated above, the present appeal is dismissed.
