Rajesh Bindal, J.

Order dated 21.07.2017, passed by the learned Single Judge, dismissing the writ petition, has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with appeal, an application seeking condonation of 78 days' delay in filing thereof, has also been filed.

Learned counsel for the appellant fairly conceded that issue raised in the present appeal is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court dated 06.03.2018, in LPA No.2297 of 2017, titled as 'Jalaluddin vs. State of Haryana and others', which was dismissed as not maintainable as the issue involved in the case in hand pertained to criminal jurisdiction.

Accordingly, for detailed reasons recorded in Jalaluddin’s case (supra), the present appeal is dismissed being not maintainable. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal, is also dismissed.
