MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral) :

On 14.11.2017 we had passed the following order :-

“We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant and have perused the impugned judgment, to find no legal infirmity therein. The appellant was concededly not having a registered sale deed in his favour on the date of consideration although he had a notarised lease agreement which he produced. Subsequently, he acquired the registered sale deed and two years after the date of consideration i.e. in 2016 when field verification was done he was fully equipped. It is contended that the process of selecting the candidate was not on the basis of scrutiny but by way of draw of lots in which the appellant was successful. There were only three applicants out of which one has already got a retail outlet elsewhere. It is further contended that the dealership has not been granted to anyone so far. Further contends that it is on account of this technicality that he has been deprived of the dealership even though he has invested a substantial amount and prays that if the Corporation takes a sympathetic view, he would get a source of livelihood.

Notice of motion only to this limited extent for 07.02.2018.”

Evidently, notice was issued for limited purpose. The respondent-Corporation states that on 29.11.2017 draw of lots was held and there were two claimants and resultantly, one Phulwinder Singh has been declared successful. The respondents have further stated that they are unable to accommodate the appellants' interest on account of the reason that this Court has already noticed the fact of his ineligibility.

The appeal is, therefore, disposed of.
