The appellant, who is a medical practitioner registered with Board of Ayurvedic and Unani System of Medicine, Haryana having passed qualification of BAMS, sought registration for installing ultra-sound machine.

As per the provisions of Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act, 1994, the appellant is not eligible. The relief was declined. As the appellant earlier had two rounds of litigation for the same relief, this court imposed cost of ₹ 2,00,000/- on him, while dismissing the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal, however, the cost imposed on him

may be waived off, as the appellant is a senior citizen.

After hearing learned counsel for the appellant and considering the fact that the appellant is BAMS doctor, hence, must be serving the society and is a senior citizen, the cost imposed by this court vide order dated 8.9.2017 is reduced to ₹ 50,000/-

With the aforesaid modification only in part of the order imposing cost, the appellant is permitted to withdraw the present appeal.
